

## Terms and Conditions

Animals in Heart of America Sale sell with a \$750 minimum bid. If the floor is not met the animal will be let out of the ring and taken back home by the consignor forfeiting the consignment fee.

The sale will be handled with the "Pass Out" option of any animal that doesn't sell for at least \$750.00 it will be an automatic "Pass Out" and animal will go directly back to consignor forfeiting their \$350.00 catalog fee with no additional "Pass Out" fees.

Catalog and sales fee - \$350.00 (includes yardage). There will be no commission.

We will be selling ads again this year in the catalogue to consignors only or non-competitive businesses. This is a great way to showcase your program and your consignments. Full-page ads are \$400.00 and half page ads are \$250.00. Front inside cover and back inside cover have already been sold.

All consignors must furnish a SEPARATE health certificate for each lot consigned. The health certificates are valid for 30 days from date of issue. Each health certificate should have the animal clearly identified by private herd number and name. Please do not identify the animals by the long number on the metal ear clip. Please identify by Private Herd number.

**Bidding:** Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder.

**Bidding Disputes:** The Auctioneer will settle any disputes as to bids and his decision of such matters shall be final.

**Terms:** Terms of sale are cash or check to the clerk at the conclusion of the auction. No funds will be released until all checks have cleared the bank, approximately 10 days. Checks are to be made to the "Heart of America Longhorns Sale".

**Certificates:** Certificates of registration will be transferred to the purchaser. Give full name and address and TLBAA or ITLA # to the sale Clerk when making payment. This will facilitate proper transfer of ownership.

**Health:** All sale cattle pass the requirements to sell in this state and most other states. Interstate health papers will be furnished within 30 days prior to the sale. Calves shall appear on the certificate with their dams. Multiple animals can be on one certificate. Each animal requires a T.B., Brucellosis, and preg status for females. Bulls must also have a Single Trick Test done along with a semen evaluation. Purchasers should consult with your state veterinarian regarding regulations in your state. All female animals 18 months of age and over and bulls 12 months of age and over must be tested negative for brucellosis not more than 30 days prior to sale. Steers do not require a brucellosis test. All female cattle between 4 and 12 months of age should be officially calfhood vaccinated.

**Announcements:** Changes of any information published in the catalog will be announced from the auction box. Such announcements will take precedence over printed material in the catalog. All catalog information or modifications are the responsibility of the seller.

**Guarantee:** All guarantees are between Buyer and Seller. All animals sold are guaranteed as represented by the owner. Females in calf, or with a calf at side, are considered breeders without further guarantee. All females vet checked with calf will be announced at sale time. All calves are given to the purchaser free and with no guarantees unless stated that it will be a split pair.

**Possession:** Immediately after the animal is sold, it will be the sole risk and responsibility of the Buyer. Possession cannot be obtained until payment is made. Buyer must make arrangements with Longhorn Opportunities for care of stock until removed. Any cattle left without arrangements being made will be removed 24 hours after the sale by Longhorn Opportunities or Seller at Buyer's expenses.

**Contract:** The above terms and guarantees shall constitute a contract between Buyer and Seller of each animal sold.

**Liability:** All persons who attend this sale do so at their risk. Longhorn Opportunities (Heart of America Longhorn Sale) nor Marysville Livestock Co. and anyone else connected with the sale, assumes no liability, legal or otherwise, for any accident or loss of life that may occur.
